# AUGUST-SEPTEMBER

---

1. [Start applications -https://goapplytexas.org/](https://goapplytexas.org/) and Common Application  
\*Fee Waivers available for students eligible for free/reduced lunch
2. Create calendar of admission and financial aid deadlines
3. Plan final campus visits-YHS allows 2 college visit days junior and senior year. (get form from the counselors' office BEFORE going )
4. Register for test dates if retaking SAT or ACT
  - ❖ Some schools are score-optional this year due to COVID
  - ❖ Still applicable to scholarships
5. Request teacher recommendations NOW-give teachers 2 weekends
  - ❖ Provide them with resume
6. Draft application essay(s)-(Check to see if necessary)

# OCTOBER

---

- 1. FAFSA Opens-<https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>**
  - ❖ Do not submit before October 1<sup>st</sup>
  - ❖ The earlier you submit, the more money available after Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>
  - ❖ Will be sending out FAFSA Night through Remind
- 2. ASVAB October 5<sup>th</sup> at YHS-Counselors' Remind for sign-up**
- 3. SAT School Day October 27<sup>th</sup> at YHS-Counselors' Remind for sign-up**
- 4. Work on application essays (if required)**
- 5. Finalize list of schools for application(s)**
- 6. Complete Early Decision and/or Early Action application(s) if applying early**
  - ❖ **Early Decision**-Early decision plans are binding - a student who is accepted as an ED applicant must attend the college
  - ❖ **Early Action**-Early action plans are nonbinding - students receive an early response to their application but do not have to commit to the college until the normal reply date of May 1

# **NOVEMBER**

---

## **1. Prepare/Submit applications**

- ❖ Request transcript, in the counselor's office, to be sent to all schools where applying

## **2. “Scrub” your social media accounts**

- ❖ **Would the boss of your dream job be proud of you for it?**
- ❖ **How are you branding yourself?-Self-absorbed?**

## **3. Research and apply for scholarships**

- ❖ **takes time to earn money**

# **DECEMBER**

---

- 1. Follow up with teachers about recommendations if needed**
- 2. Send test scores and transcripts-(August-December)**
- 3. Submit applications before winter break so you can enjoy the holidays!**
- 4. Callaway Scholarship-10 Community Service Hours due**
  - ❖ December 16<sup>th</sup>-No Exceptions**

# **JANUARY**

---

- 1. Submit applications to colleges with late deadlines**
- 2. Make financial plans considering award from FAFSA**
  - ❖ Please submit FAFSA if you have not already
- 3. Housing Applications?**
- 4. Junior College and Technical Schools?**
  - ❖ **Make sure you take ELAR and Math TSI**
    - Email with a TSI sign-up will be sent followed by a remind
    - Must complete TSI Pre-assessment before you can be scheduled

---

1. Check “admitted student” events at colleges you’re considering
2. Choose your college and mail the deposit by May 1<sup>st</sup>(most schools)!
3. Finalize Housing Applications

---

1. Inform teachers who wrote recommendations of your choice

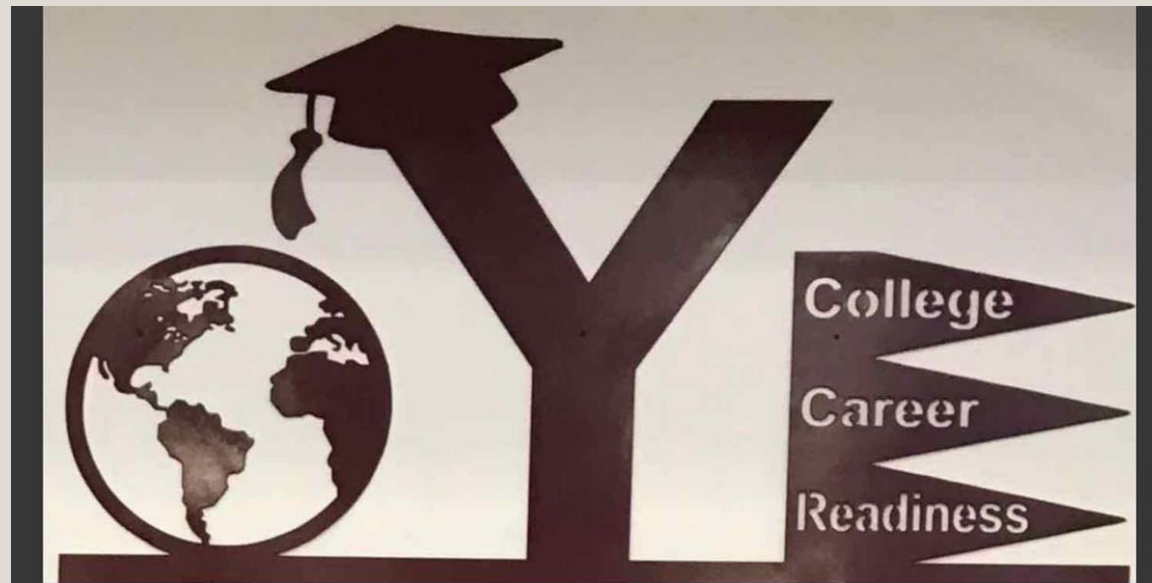
