October 23, 2013 Minutes

Members present: Diane Leftwich, Lindsey Summers, Abbie Hanke, Dale Keen, George Willey, and Tammy Wimmer

Called to order at 4:01pm.

Minutes from the April 10, 2013 meeting were read and approved with a motion made by Diane Leftwich and seconded by Dr. Willey.

The committee discussed the Smile Program. The mobile dentist saw 61 students at Ben Milam Elementary. They were scheduled to return to Cameron Elementary on December 2<sup>nd</sup>.

The Staff Flu Clinic was scheduled for November 1<sup>st</sup>. Cameron ISD will again pay for staff members to receive this vaccine.

The committee discussed at length in finding a way to assist students with vision services. C ISD transportation may possibly play a role in getting students to and from vision exams. Tammy Wimmer is to coordinate with Communities in Schools to get them involved in the process. Lindsey Summers is to assist in getting the Medicaid flyers for information.

The annual Walk for Yoe Life was set for Saturday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Dr. Willey discussed the new CPR training requirements for students. He will look into coordinating with AMR on integrating this into our current curriculum.

Dr. Willey discussed the possibility of a partnership with Little River Healthcare that would provide the district with either a physician's assistant or nurse practitioner. Dr. Willey stated that Rockdale ISD has started a partnership with LRMC already on a trial basis. Dr. Willey and Tammy Wimmer will visit Rockdale ISD in the spring to see how the process works. More information on this will be available later in the school year.

The next scheduled meeting will be Wednesday, December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013.
