

Cameron Prep School

Our focus for Cameron Prep School is shifting this semester from offering generalized help for our students in need to giving specific guidance to students in areas they have failed during the first semester.

Students who have failed two or more core classes for the first semester will be assigned to Cameron Prep School. Each day, students will be assigned to a certified teacher in their area of need. Students will receive tutoring, complete homework, read AR books, and complete missing assignments during this time.

Teachers will send missing assignments to Michelle Evan to be distributed to the appropriate CPS teachers. When all required work is finished, the student may then be eligible to go to the computer lab to access Study Island. Teachers will assess what tested TEKS students need to work on during Study Island time. Send those TEKS to Michelle, as well, in order for a program to be set up for each child.

In keeping with 8th Grade's current policy, 8th grade students who are assigned at the beginning of the semester will remain on the list for the entire semester. New 8th grade students will be added if necessary.

Sixth and seventh grade students will be evaluated after each grading period—3 weeks and 6 weeks—to determine Cameron Prep School requirement.

Teachers may invite students that they feel would benefit from Cameron Prep School. Students may also come on a volunteer basis. These students will have the option of attending a specific subject areas or going to Study Island.

Band students who are assigned to Cameron Prep School will be excused one day a week to attend Sectional Practice.
